The Board is committed to fulfilling its responsibilities to:

- Represent the public interest
- Establish policies that define the institutional mission and set prudent, ethical and legal standards for college operations
- Hire and evaluate the District Chancellor
- Delegate power and authority to the District Chancellor to effectively lead the District
- Assure fiscal health and stability
- Monitor institutional performance and educational quality
- Advocate and protect the District

The Board also developed written ends policies and governance principles that address the broadest levels of all organizational decisions and situations.
