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BP 2512 ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL MATTERS

Reference:

Title 5 Section 53200

The District Chancellor or his/her designee or the Academic Senate Presidents or their designees are responsible for the initiation and facilitation of appropriate collegial consultation on “academic and professional matters,” as follows:

1. Curriculum, including establishing prerequisites and placing courses within disciplines
2. Degree and certificate requirements
3. Grading policies
4. Educational program development
5. Standards or policies regarding student preparation and success
6. District and college governance structure, as related to faculty roles
7. Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including self-study and annual reports
8. Policies for faculty professional development
9. Processes for program review
10. Processes for institutional planning and budget development, and
11. Other academic professional matters as mutually agreed upon between the Board of Trustees and the Academic Senates
