## **BP 4050 ARTICULATION**

WASC/ACCJC Accreditation Standard II.A.10

In consultation with the Academic Senate of a college (which shall recommend and approve the procedures), the District Chancellor shall establish administrative procedures that assure appropriate articulation of the college's educational programs with baccalaureate institutions and proximate high schools.

The procedures also may support articulation with institutions, including other community colleges and those that are not geographically proximate but that are appropriate and advantageous for partnership with the District.

All articulated courses must be from fully accredited regional U.S. institutions and recognized by the Department of Education.

Articulated courses will be applied to the AA/AS degrees once 12 units of satisfactory work with a "C" or better, have been completed at the college awarding the degree.

Articulated courses will be applied to certificates of more than six units after a minimum of six units of satisfactory work, with a "C" or better, has been completed in the certificate at the college awarding the certificate.
