BP 4100 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Arts for Transfer and Associate in Science for Transfer to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate upon successful completion of a minimum of 12 or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework designed as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education.

The District Chancellor shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the local curriculum committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published in the

District's catalog(s) and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
