## **BP 7130 COMPENSATION**

Salary schedules, compensation, and benefits, including health and welfare benefits, for all classes of employees and each contract employee shall be established by the Board of Trustees or the respective collective bargaining agreement.

Refer to the applicable collective bargaining agreements for specific compensation-related details.

### **Prohibition of Incentive Compensation**

**NOTE:** *Except as applicable to foreign students residing in foreign countries who are not eligible to receive federal student assistance,*

The District shall not provide any commission, bonus, or other incentive payment based, directly or indirectly, on the success in securing enrollments or financial aid, to any person or entity engaged in any student recruiting or admission activities or in making decisions regarding the award of student financial assistance. Employees covered by this ban shall be referred to as “covered employees” for purposes of this policy.
