BP 7600 COLLEGE POLICE DEPARTMENT

Education Code Sections 72330, et seq.

The Board has established a police department under the supervision of the Chief of Police, who shall report directly to the Vice Chancellor of Administrative Services. The purpose of the department is to enforce the law on or near the campuses and other grounds or properties owned, operated, controlled or administered by the District or by the State acting on behalf of the District.

District police officers shall be employed as members of the classified service but shall, when duly sworn, be peace officers as defined by law. Prior to employment, they shall satisfy the training requirements set out in Penal Code Sections 830, *et seq.* The Chancellor shall establish minimum qualifications of employment for the Chief of Police including, but not limited to, prior employment as a peace officer or completion of a peace officer training course approved by the Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training.

The Chancellor shall ensure that every member of the police department first employed by the District before July 1, 1999 satisfies the requirements of state law regarding qualifications for continued employment.

Every member of the police department shall be issued a suitable identification card and badge bearing words "San Jose/Evergreen Community College Police". The Vice Chancellor of Administrative Services, in cooperation with the Chief of Police, shall issue such other regulations as may be necessary for the administration of the police department.
