## **AP 2105 ELECTION OF STUDENT MEMBERS**

### **Reference:**

Education Code Section 72023.5

The student members shall be elected by a plurality vote of those voting in a regular election of the student body. All members of the student body may vote. Normally, the election will be conducted during the spring semester and will be completed in time for the student members to take office at the first board meeting in June.

The student members may be recalled in an election conducted in the same manner as the election to office. An election will be called upon presentation to the District Chancellor of a petition signed by at least 10% of the students enrolled at the time of filing the petition. No recall election will be held if the petition is received within 30 days of a regularly scheduled election for the student members.

The office shall become vacant if a student member becomes ineligible for the office, resigns, is recalled, or dies. If the seat of a student member becomes vacant during his/her term, the Board of Trustees may authorize the officers of student body associations (established pursuant to Education Code Section 76060 at each community college in the District) to appoint a student to serve the remainder of the term in accordance with procedures established by the Board of Trustees.
