## **AP 2365 RECORDING**

### **References:**

Government Code Sections 54953.5 and 54953.6

At the request of the Board of Trustees, regular meetings may be recorded and shall be subject to inspection by members of the public in accordance with the California Public Records Act. The recording shall be retained and erased 30 days after the meeting.

Recordings are available for inspection by the public in the District Chancellor's Office. Copies of recordings can be obtained through written request to the District Chancellor's Office and are provided upon payment of a fee covering the current direct cost of duplication.

No other recording device shall be used at any Board meeting in such a way that it interferes with the regular conduct of the meeting.
