Performance

Evaluation of the District Chancellor by the Board of Trustees is to be based upon performance of the duties outlined in the job description for that position and upon goals and objectives developed annually by the Board of Trustees and the Chancellor, consistent with BP 2435 titled Evaluation of the District Chancellor and BP 2430 titled Delegation of Authority to the District Chancellor. The District Chancellor's performance shall also be monitored to determine whether he/she has met the expectations expressed in the Board's Ends Policies and Governance Principles.

Performance goals and objectives are personal to the administrator, confidential, part of the evaluation process, discussed as a part of the evaluation only in closed session, and are not released to the public.
