AP 3200 ACCREDITATION

The San Jose Evergreen Community College District strives to comply with the eligibility requirements, accreditation standards, and policies of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC). The District is timely and responsive in meeting the reporting and policy requirements of the Commission. All colleges within the District engage in an inclusive and collaborative process for developing a comprehensive self-evaluation for reaffirmation of accreditation.

The District and its colleges make complete and accurate disclosures in order to comply with ACCJC requests, directives, and decisions.

The following is the process for completion of self-evaluations as required by ACCJC:

1. The development of a Self-Evaluation Report and any evidence and materials to support accreditation or reaffirmation of accreditation begins in a timely manner before the visiting team arrives on campus.
2. The college presidents will appoint an Accreditation Liaison Officer who is responsible for coordinating all necessary activities in preparation for the accreditation visit and any subsequent reports and visits.
3. Each college and the district office will have an Accreditation Committee with members from faculty, management, classified staff, and students.
4. The Accreditation Committees will work to support the writing of the self-evaluation and any other reports required by the ACCJC.
5. The self-evaluation report will be made available to the faculty, classified staff, managers, and student leaders for review and comment before it is sent to the Board of Trustees for approval.

The self-evaluation and any subsequent reports required by the ACCJC shall be approved by the SJECCD Board of Trustees before they are submitted to the ACCJC.
