AP 4010 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The Academic calendar is negotiated with AFT 6157 annually. The District follows a compressed schedule for fall and spring for a total of 32 weeks (156 instructional days). The academic year consists of 175 days of instruction. Four 6-hour flex days are included in the 175 days.

Statutory holidays are observed on the dates noted, or on alternate dates in accordance with Education Code 79020 and include:

- New Year's Day (January 1)
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
- Friday in February prior to Washington's Day
- Third Monday in February known as Washington Day
- Cesar Chavez Holiday celebrated as a holiday on the Friday of Spring Break
- Last Monday in May, known as Memorial Day
- July 4, known as Independence Day
- First Monday in September, known as Labor Day
- November 11 or another day known as, Veterans Day
- Thursday in November that is proclaimed as Thanksgiving Day and the Friday following Thanksgiving Day
- December 24
- December 25
- December 31
- A Floating Holiday set
September 9, or another day, known as Admissions Day is a Board-granted holiday during Christmas- New Year's break.
