The library and information hubs will offer a full range of library resources and services.

It is the aim of the library to provide a balanced collection of significant materials that will enrich and support the curriculum, aid the individual in the pursuit of information, provide a broad view of cultural heritage and diversity, promote aesthetic appreciation, present varied points of view concerning contemporary problems and issues, furnish intellectual stimulation, and invite the creative use of leisure time.

The selection and evaluation of materials will be based on curricular demands, the recommendations of current professional review sources, plus the suggestions and requests of members of the college community.

All faculty, staff, and currently enrolled students may borrow materials. The open computer labs will be open first and foremost to students currently enrolled at the colleges.
