AP 5400 ASSOCIATED STUDENTS ORGANIZATION

Reference:

Education Code Section 76060

Each college in the District shall have an Associated Students Government.

Both day and evening student representatives shall be encouraged.

A governing body shall be elected that shall keep an account of its meetings, expenditures, authorizations and policies established.

A simple majority of the elected voting members of the Associated Students Organization governing body shall constitute a quorum.

The District shall have one Associated Students Organization which shall be known as the Associated Students (AS).

A governing body shall be elected which shall be known as the AS Executive Board. It shall keep an account of its meetings, expenditures, authorizations, and policies established. Minimum standards for membership to the AS Executive Board shall be defined by the association's constitution and bylaws. The governing body will coordinate and integrate its own and the activities of all campus clubs and organizations of the District, and will control the funds of the AS organizations and all related

organizations operating under its authority. Both day and evening student representatives shall be encouraged.

A simple majority of the elected voting members of the AS governing body shall constitute a quorum.

Students will exercise their opportunity to participate in campus governance through AS and through appointments to campus committees that review, analyze, and formulate District policies and procedures. Student appointments to these committees will be made by the AS.
