AP 6360 CONTRACTS – ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS AND MATERIALS

The District may contract with any vendor who has submitted one of the three lowest responsible competitive proposals or competitive bids for the purchase or maintenance of electronic data-processing systems and equipment, electronic telecommunication equipment, supporting software, and related material, goods and services. Bids shall be solicited and contracts shall be awarded in accordance with AP 6340 titled Bids and Contracts.

Criteria to determine what constitutes a responsive bid shall be established by the Chief Technology Officer.

Supplemental instructional software packages may be purchased without taking estimates or advertising for bids in accordance with AP 6340 titled Bids and Contracts.

Sale and leaseback of data-processing equipment or another major item of equipment is permissible if the purchaser agrees to lease the item back to the District for use by the District following the sale. The Board of Trustees shall first adopt a resolution finding that the sale or leaseback is the most economical means for providing electronic data-processing equipment or other major items of equipment to the District.
