4. Demonstrate competency in the basic skills of the goal keeper.
5. Demonstrate the proper throw-in technique.
6. Demonstrate competency in the knowledge in the laws of soccer.
7. Analyze the three person referee system as used throughout the international game of soccer.
8. Identify positions of the players on the field and the related responsibilities.
