

NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATION AND CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE TITLE IX COORDINATOR

The San José·Evergreen Community College District is committed to providing an educational and employment environment free of unlawful harassment / discrimination.

Board Policy 3410 contains the District's policy against all forms of harassment, including sexual harassment. Sexual harassment is a form of unlawful discrimination. District Board Policies, state and federal laws prohibit all forms of unlawful discrimination. Board Policy (BP) 3410 describes the District's commitment to nondiscrimination and Administrative Procedure (AP) 3435 explains how reports and complaints of discrimination are filed and investigated. Board Policy 3410 and Administrative Procedure 3435 contain the District's policy and procedures, respectively, that ensure that students, faculty, and staff who experience sexual harassment or discrimination receive appropriate information regarding on and off campus resources, and that educational information about preventing sexual violence is provided and publicized.

You should know that all SJECCD employees have a duty to report discrimination or sexual harassment if:

- They become aware of acts of discrimination or sexual harassment
- They have witness acts of discrimination or sexual harassment.
- Any member of the campus community reports acts of discrimination or sexual harassment to them.
