# *Did You Know...*

## *History*

- San Jose City College was founded in 1921 with the establishment of a District Office in 1963, making SJECCD the oldest community college district in Northern California.

## *Student Demographics*

- Over half of the district's student population is female.
- The largest ethnic group among students at San Jose City College is Hispanic. The largest ethnic group among students at Evergreen Valley College is Asian/Pacific Islander.

## *Academic Programs*

- The academic programs with the most course enrollments at both San Jose City and Evergreen Valley are Mathematics, English, History, Psychology, and Physical Education.

## *Financial Aid*

- 50% of students within the district are on financial aid. That's a total of \$34,753,214 in Fiscal Year 2013-2014.

## *Employee Demographics*

- Our employees represent the diversity within our community: 42% are white; 23% are Asian; 22% are Hispanic; and 7% are African-American.
- 50 percent of the faculty at both San Jose City and Evergreen Valley are minorities.
- 62% of our full-time faculty is tenured.

## *Transfer*

- The percentage of students who transfer from SJECCD colleges after 6 years of matriculation is 38.2%.

## *The Community*

- A third of San Jose's population is of Hispanic or Latino descent.
- There are approximately 33,000 veterans living in San Jose.
- Around 39% of the city's population is foreign born.
- Only 37% of persons age 25+ years have a bachelor's degree or higher.
