In May 2014, GASB approved the issuance of two OPEB Statements designed to enhance accounting and financial reporting by state & local governments. The OPEB Employer Exposure Draft is entitled "Accounting and Financial Reporting for Postemployment Benefits Other than Pensions". The **OPEB Plan Exposure** Draft is entitled "Financial Reporting for Postemployment Benefit Plans other than Pension Plans." The "OPEB Employer Exposure Draft" proposes guidance for reporting by governments that provide OPEB to their employees and for governments that are legally required to finance OPEB for employees of other employers. The "OPEB Plan Exposure Draft" addresses reporting for OPEB Plans that administer those benefits on behalf of the governments. These proposals are designed to bring about advances in accounting and financial reporting for OPEB similar to those that result from the Board's pension standards established
