Purpose: The purpose of the self-evaluation is to provide an opportunity for introspection in your performance review.

Please discuss the following in your self-evaluation:

1. Response to recommendations of previous review if appropriate.
2. Changes in assignment, course development activities, or any other activities that have affected your assignment since your last review if appropriate.
3. Any professional growth activities undertaken since your last review if appropriate for the assignment.
4. Professional Criteria as defined in the contract and as appropriate for the assignment.
5. Collegial Criteria as defined in the contract and as appropriate for the assignment.
6. Organizational Criteria as defined in the contract and as appropriate for the assignment.
7. How you employ teaching, learning and professional practices that demonstrate the ability to work with and serve individuals within a diverse campus environment. Including multiple perspectives and equitable representation as appropriate to the subject/assignment/service area that reflect Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Accessibility and Anti-Racism/Anti-Bias (DEIAA) principles.
8. Any professional accomplishments such as publications and/or awards.
9. Any other notable accomplishments or achievements.
